Communion to the Homebound

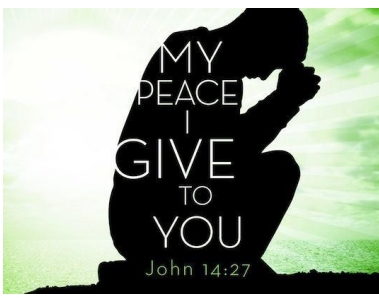
