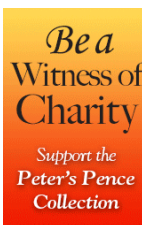

## *Does God have a plan for each of us?*

We collaborate with God through continual prayer and discernment in planning out our best path of life. This path allows us to fulfill God's ultimate plan—namely, to find meaning in the life he gave us, enjoy his friendship while on earth, and spend eternal life with him in heaven.

God doesn't force us to live out our existence in some programmed, robotic way according to a predestined plan or inevitable fate over which we have no control. Rather, we're free and responsible for our own actions.

Moreover, God's plan for each of us is to experience his profound love and love him in return. "God is love, and whoever remains in love remains in God and God in him" (1 John 4:16). As the supreme sign of God's love, his plan of salvation from the beginning of time was to send us his only begotten Son. "Jesus' violent death was not the result of chance in an unfortunate coincidence of circumstances, but is part of the mystery of God's plan, as St. Peter explains...in his first sermon on Pentecost: "This Jesus [was] delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 599). "By giving up his own Son for our sins, God manifests that his plan for us is one of benevolent love, prior to any merit on our part" (CCC 604).

## Feasts and Saints of the Week



**St. Junipero Serra** – Feast Day is July 1<sup>st</sup>. He was an 18<sup>th</sup> century Spanish Franciscan priest and missionary. Known as "the Apostle of California" and "the Father of the California Missions," he conducted his life in radical service to others and spread the Gospel to all those he met. He had a special love for the Indians and brought them the faith, protection, instruction in agriculture, and better living conditions. He was canonized by Pope Francis in 2015 and is the patron saint of California, Hispanic Americans, and religious vocations.



**St. Thomas, the Apostle** – Feast Day is July 3<sup>rd</sup>. Known also as Didymus (Greek for twin), he was one of the 12 Apostles. He's known as "Doubting Thomas" for his lack of faith in Jesus' Resurrection and his demand of physical proof of his wounds from His crucifixion. His utterance, "My Lord and my God" teaches us how Jesus wants us all to relate to Him. He went on to spread the teachings of Jesus in India and was martyred there by beheading. He is the patron saint of India, judges, as well as, architects, as he was involved in building work in India.



**St. Maria Goretti** – Feast Day is July 6<sup>th</sup>. An Italian virgin martyr in the 19<sup>th</sup> c, she was one of the youngest saints to be canonized at the age of 11 years old. Known for her commitment to purity and courageous defense of her faith, she preferred to die rather than submit to her attacker's sexual advances and sin against God. Having suffered 14 stab wounds to her torso, she forgave him on her death bed and is known as "The Little Saint of Great Mercy." She is the patron saint of forgiveness, purity, chastity, rape victims, and youth.
