

April Family of the Month

The Knights of Columbus honors our April Family of the Month: **Nadine** and Lawrence Woode.

Larry and Nadine have been parishioners at Immaculate Conception since 2004. They both serve as Extraordinary Ministers (EM) of Holy Communion and as Lectors/Readers. Nadine also serves as the Chair of our parish's Bereavement Ministry. She meets with family members and coordinates all church-related support for the funeral mass, wake service and burial. Larry assists by handling the Sacristan duties during the funeral mass. In another capacity, he also serves as a presider for communion services whenever Fr. Nick is not available to celebrate a weekday mass.

Both Larry and Nadine are keiki o ka aina. Larry grew up on the Hawaiian Homestead in Nanakuli; attended St. Joseph's Grade School in Waipahu; and graduated from St. Louis School in 1962. Nadine grew up in Ewa; attended Ewa Elementary; and received First Communion and Confirmation at Immaculate Conception Church. Her family later moved to Makaha where she graduated from Waianae High School in 1965.

Larry and Nadine were married at St. Rita's Church in Nanakuli in 1965; moved from Nanakuli to Waipahu in 1968; then "temporarily" left the islands in 1970 after Larry returned from Vietnam. They travelled extensively, compliments of the U. S. Army, and enjoyed the rich camaraderie and community of the military ohana. Following tours in Germany, Kentucky, Washington State, Pennsylvania and Texas, Larry retired in 1988 after a 4-year assignment on the faculty of the U. S. Army Command and General Staff College, Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.

Meanwhile, Nadine continued work as a Registered Nurse (RN) at various hospitals throughout the Continental United States. After moving back to Hawaii in 2004, Nadine eventually retired in 2012 after serving as the Assistant Head Nurse in the Cardiac/Telemetry Unit at the Tripler Army Medical Center.

Nadine and Larry have 2 children. Their son, Napali, a graduate of the University of Notre Dame, is a Financial Consultant and Realtor. Their daughter, Laverne, a graduate of Chamberlain University College of Nursing, is a hospital RN in Iowa. Neither children are married; so, unfortunately, no grandchildren. 
